A NOTE FROM AUGUSTINE PAYNE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear friends,

It is evident and frightening that the Democrats want to parade the idea of no restrictions on abortion. The most recent example of that happened during the State of the Union Speech, when President Biden, talking about the topic of abortion, stated, “My g*d, what freedoms will you take away next?” Another recent example is the vice president Kamala Harris' “reproductive freedoms tour,” where she’s going around the country touting how great abortion is and that women need access to it through all nine months. Her tour included a visit to a Planned Parenthood Abortion clinic. Sadly, there are many other examples where increasing abortion is the issue that Democrats are hyper-focused on, and they are showing they will do that until a majority of American people wake up.

Avoiding talking about it has proven not to work.

U.S. Senator John Kennedy (Louisiana), during a Senate Budget Committee hearing on “Abortion Access and Economic Costs,” was given time to interview the experts that were invited to testify and answer questions.

I would like to highlight three things from that exchange that would be beneficial for pro-life people who are in public office.

1) Senator Kennedy asked the economics professor (Prof. Caitlin Myers), who is in favor of abortion, is the fetus or baby dead or alive after an abortion? There was some hesitation and visible discomfort in answering it, and then, when pressed, she said it is dead after an abortion.

2) Then he asked if she supported abortion up until birth for a healthy mother and a healthy baby. The economics professor claimed it just doesn’t happen and then proceeded to skirt the question. As you have seen in previous newsletter issues, later-term abortions (abortion after 20 weeks) on a healthy mom and healthy baby do happen, and they happen a lot. Please see my articles from newsletters in October 2023, November 2023, and January 2024 for more factual data. He then asked the same question to Dr. Leilah Zahedi-Spung, who is also pro-abortion; she stated that Senator Kennedy was using “inflammatory language to describe a medical procedure” and then proceeded to skirt the question.

3) He used a scientific picture of a child at 21 weeks to show the development of a child (*please see the image below*) highlighting that this child can feel pain. He then proceeded to describe the abortion procedure that would be used to kill the child at that age.

The pro-life message will experience more success in the political arena if pro-life politicians are willing to expose the radicalness of the pro-abortion agenda by the three things highlighted above (abortion kills a human being and shows the development of the child, abortion is legal up until birth for a healthy mom and healthy child in several states and being advocated for nationwide, and the horrors of the abortion procedures), but I would also add

If the general public sees what we are doing for women and learns of the horrific reality of abortion, we will start to see pro-life victories around the country.

PRO-LIFE COURT & LEGISLATION UPDATE

Dear Pro-Life friends,

Lots of news from all over the place: Iowa, other states, the world.

IOWA COURT NEWS

The so called “heartbeat” law is set for oral argument in the Iowa Supreme Court on April 11th. At this time, Attorney General Brenna Bird’s staff of prolife lawyers will battle the pro-abortion lawyers of Planned Parenthood and make their arguments verbally to the 7 Justices of the Iowa Supreme Court in Des Moines. The Justices also will question the attorneys from both sides. The case has finally reached this stage after the Iowa Supreme Court threw out Iowa’s former heartbeat law, calling it a “hypothetical law” because it had been passed while *Roe v. Wade* was the law of the land. You will recall the Republicans in the Iowa Legislature then re-passed the heartbeat law in a special session in July of 2023. Planned Parenthood sued to stop the law from going into effect, and for the last year the case has been winding its way through the Iowa court system. A decision by the Iowa Supreme Court is expected sometime between April 11th and June, 2024.

IOWA LEGISLATIVE NEWS

The “funnel” (i.e., deadline) in the Iowa legislature by which date all bills must be passed out of committee by both the House and Senate was Friday, March 15, 2024. The following bills survived the funnel and are alive for further consideration this year:

HF 2276- Zoning protection for maternity homes (like Mary’s Inn)

SF 2095- Religious Freedom Restoration Act to protect citizens from overreaching by the State unless the State has a “compelling interest.” It could be used by healthcare workers to sue if they are forced against their religion to perform abortions.

HF 2617- the so-called “Baby Olivia” bill that requires schools to show 7–12th graders a video “comparable to” Baby Olivia showing human development from fertilization to birth, including the development of all vital organs. See the Baby Olivia video at <https://babyolivia.liveaction.org/>.

SF 2095- Increase Medicaid eligibility post birth for new moms from 6 months to 1 year.

HF 2267- MOMS bill (More Options for Maternal Support)- cleans up some language to hopefully get the money flowing to new moms and allow a private organization to take over management from the State of Iowa.

HF 2637- Increases the Adoption Tax Credit from \$5,000 to \$20,000.

Bills that are dead for this year include:

HF 2363- Would add childbirth to the expenses dads are required to pay for any child of theirs born out of wedlock.

HF 2395- Would mandate the Iowa DHS to compile and post a list for doctors to offer a pregnant mom whose child is likely to die in utero or within 3 months of birth, informing the mom of perinatal “counseling and medical care by maternal-fetal medical specialists, obstetricians, neonatologists, anesthesia specialists, clergy, social workers, and specialty nurses focused on alleviating fear and ensuring that the pregnant woman and her family experience the life and death of the child in a comfortable and supportive environment.” This new law would be called “Compassion and Care for Medically Challenging Pregnancies Act.”

SF 252- Would mandate state colleges and universities and their staff to provide “reasonable accommodations” to protect pregnant students including rescheduling

tests and taking a leave of absence if necessary due to pregnancy appointments, care, or doctor recommendations.

HF 2518- Would allow parents to sue for the death of their unborn child if he or she was killed in an auto accident.

OTHER STATES

Alabama-- After its Supreme Court ruled frozen embryos are human beings (see last month's Newsletter, pages 5-6) the Alabama legislature passed a new law. The new law provides "civil and criminal immunity for death or damage to an embryo to any individual or entity when providing or receiving services related to in vitro fertilization." This was termed a "stop gap" law in response to IVF supporters' outcry after the court's decision. You will recall in the Alabama court case, frozen embryos were dropped and killed when a wayward patient stumbled into the freezer lab via an unlocked door, took out the embryos, was "burned" by the freezing test tubes, and dropped the embryos on the floor. The parents sued, claiming that their human children had been killed and that under the "wrongful death" law in Alabama they should be awarded "damages" (i.e., money) from the careless cryogenic lab that left the door unlocked. Interestingly, the new law now protects IVF labs and staff from such lawsuits and any criminal prosecution, so the IVF parents in the actual case are now out of luck because the law applies retroactively. Future IVF patients in Alabama will now be at the mercy of the labs and staff, and it will be normal operating procedure to "discard and destroy" unused and unwanted human embryos even if the parents object. So, the protection of the IVF doctors and labs has come at the expense of the human embryos AND the IVF supporters who insisted on the new law.

Illinois—2019 law allows unrestricted abortion because it says: "Every individual who becomes pregnant has a fundamental right to continue the pregnancy and give birth or to have an abortion, and to make autonomous decisions about how to exercise that right." No court fight to challenge this law is occurring at this time.

Minnesota—In 1995 the Supreme Court found a right to abortion in Minnesota's state constitution. In 2023, the legislature and governor passed laws that make abortion on demand legal, bans any county or city from passing any pro-life law to the contrary, repealed the 24-hour waiting period/informed consent protection for expectant moms, and approved non-cooperation with any inquiry from a pro-life state about Minnesota doctors coming to their state to perform abortions. No court fight to challenge this law is occurring at this time.

Wisconsin—Law presumably protects unborn people after 20 weeks "postfertilization," or 22 weeks after the last menstrual period, and provides a 24-hour waiting period. But this law is in flux due to a court case involving the legal effect of a pre-Roe v. Wade state law that is currently the subject of a Planned Parenthood lawsuit filed on February 22, 2024, in which the Wisconsin Supreme Court is being asked to rule all protective laws unconstitutional.

Nebraska—March 5, 2024, the Nebraska Supreme Court heard oral arguments on the 12-week protective law passed by the Nebraska legislature. A decision is expected before the end of spring. As usual, the ACLU and Planned Parenthood are challenging the pro-life law. Also, it is expected that pro-abortion forces will obtain enough signatures to put a constitutional amendment on the November ballot that allows abortion up to viability and "when needed to protect the life or health of the pregnant patient." There is no definition of "health" so the amendment will allow abortion on demand if it succeeds.

Missouri—Unborn people are protected by state law except in cases of a medical emergency when "a delay will create a serious risk of substantial and irreversible physical impairment of a major bodily function." A constitutional amendment is likely to appear on the November 5, 2024 ballot that would allow any abortion if necessary to "protect the life or physical or mental health of the pregnant person." This would essentially allow abortion on demand.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

France---became the first and only country (other than what the U.S. did in Roe v. Wade) to make abortion an official, explicit part of the French Constitution. The parliamentary vote inserted the clause “the law determines the conditions by which is exercised the freedom of women to have recourse to an abortion, which is guaranteed.” French President Emmanuel Macron was a vocal advocate for the amendment.

So, there you have it. Like other news, some is good and some is bad. Keep reading, listening, and viewing...it is up to us to educate the world on the humanity of preborn people and the truth that there are positive pro-life alternatives to abortion. Dubuque County Right to Life will keep you posted.

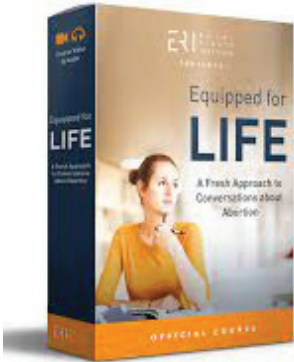

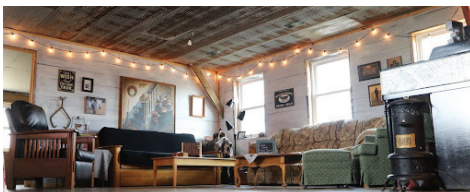
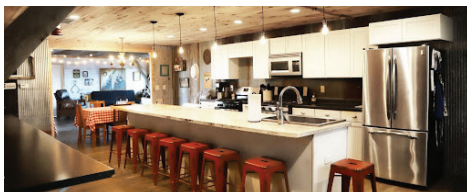
