About our keynote speaker:

Jason Jones is a film producer, author, activist, popular podcast host, and human rights worker. He is president of the Human Rights Education Organization (H.E.R.O.), the director of The Vulnerable People Project, and a senior contributor to The Stream.

Through a series of life-changing events, Jason has been an advocate for pre-born children for many decades. He produced two pro-life films: The first in 2006, Jason was an Executive Producer of "Bella," which won several film industry awards, most notably the People's Choice Award at the 2006 Toronto International Film Festival. The second pro-life film is called Divided Hearts of America and is available on DVD and streaming on Fox Nation.

He is also the author of two books, The Race to Save Our Century: Five Core Principles to Promote Peace, Freedom, and a Culture Of Life, and his most recent, The World is on Fire: A Whole Life Reader.

Jason was also involved in advocating for other vulnerable populations. In 2009, he was part of a coalition that delivered over 2mm in medicine and drilled wells in the most remote corners of Sudan. In 2012, he was the Producer of the T.V. movie "Mother Marianne: Portrait of a Saint" and an Executive Producer of the new film "Voiceless".

Jason's short films include "Eyes to See" (2010), "Crescendo" (2011), "Sing a Little Louder" (2015), and "Special Flavor" (2016). In 2015, Jason went to the frontlines in Iraq in the war against ISIS and directed a documentary for policymakers on the plight of religious minorities. Jason is a leading voice in the world for the Uyghurs as they face ongoing persecution and internment in China. Jason works directly to aid the homeless, people facing genocide, and women with crisis pregnancies.

A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Pro-Life Friends,

In the March newsletter I made a mistake. I mentioned that we faced resistance at Loras without reaching out to Loras' leadership to ensure the college leadership was aware of the situation and given the opportunity to respond to it. I'm sorry to the Loras College administration and the whole Loras community for my mistake.

My intention was to update you on the progress of the projects we discussed at the last LIFE Dinner, as hundreds of you generously contributed towards this cause. Regardless of intent, it was my mistake not to notify Loras College so their leadership could look into it.

Fortunately, we've been able to meet with Loras Leadership. As representatives of the Loras community, they have graciously accepted my apology. I'm grateful for their openness and for their immediate desire to partner with Dubuque County Right To Life to create educational opportunities for Loras students and to have open dialogue on the issue of abortion.

I look forward to partnering together with Loras College and keeping you updated on the pro-life initiatives that are taking place there.

January Marist/Knights of Columbus Poll Results

62% of respondents described themselves as pro-choice (tragically, this is a 4% increase from last year's poll results), and 36% described themselves as pro-life.

A couple of interesting findings that I was not aware of before:

- A whopping 82% of respondents believed that it is possible to “have laws which protect both the health and well-being of a woman and the life of the unborn.” Based on my discussions with people out in the community, they don't believe the laws are adequately protecting the life of the mother in states that protect the pre-born. This belief is largely formed by the pro-abortion media pushing the narrative that pregnant women will die in pro-life states. You may recall the tragic story of Amber Thurman or stories related to Texas Heartbeat Law causing an increase in maternal mortality rates; that is just a small sample of what the media is showing their viewers. Every state that has protections for pre-born human beings has the life of the mother exception. DCRTL exists not only to make you aware of what is actually happening but also examples like this show why we must also be out in the general community, making the general public aware of the truth about pro-life laws and that women will be protected.
- Another finding is that 83% of the respondents support or strongly support pregnancy resource centers. 80% of those who are pro-choice strongly support or support pregnancy resource centers. Many people are unaware of the support available to them in their community . They believe that abortion is their only option because no one is there for them, and abortion appears as the easy and quick fix to their pregnancy. Part of our outreach has focused on promoting the availability of pregnancy and parenting resources within our community. We must promote these resources so people will know there are organizations ready to help them through their situation.

Doing outreach at the Dubuque County Fair and other places not only allows us to talk with people about their beliefs on the issue of abortion, but we are also able to connect people with the resources available to help them and counter the lies they see in the media about pro-life laws. Doing outreach in our community is crucial to furthering our cause.

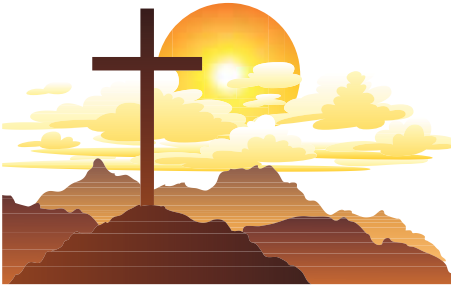

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life -

IOWA NEWS

The so-called “Baby Olivia” bill sent over by the Iowa Senate is still pending in the Iowa House of Representatives in Des Moines as HF 391. As reported last month, the Senate version of this bill would require students in grades 4-12th be shown a “A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation, or an ultrasound or other real image, that depicts the humanity of the unborn child by showing prenatal human development, starting at fertilization, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ development throughout every stage of pregnancy.” The House version is different, but it needs to match the Senate version in order to go right to Governor Reynolds for her signature. Pro-life lobbyists are working hard in Des Moines to help Representatives work their way through it, so some version of this much-needed bill can get to the governor’s desk this legislative session and become law for the 2025-2026 school year.

The other bill I referenced in the March Newsletter was House Study Bill (HSB) 186 which would stop or at least slow down out-of-state abortionists from freely peddling abortion pills in Iowa. It is now out of committee and eligible for debate and passage in the House as HF 775. It requires the abortionist to inform the mother in writing“of all of the risks commonly associated with a medication abortion, that it may be possible to reverse the intended effects of a medication abortion if the woman changes her mind but that time is of the essence, and that information on and assistance with reversing the effects of a medication abortion is available on the department of health and human services internet.” It also would require such pills to be dispensed in a “health care setting,” which means a hospital, clinic, or doctor’s office. Currently, these death pills come right to the door of the distressed woman for her to ingest alone...and then deliver her dead baby in a bathroom toilet. It is a barbaric practice and does women no favors. HF 775 will protect women from this horror. Remember, this bill does NOT call for any civil liability or criminal charges against the women who might take these abortion death pills. It will not penalize women. It is meant to stop the abortionists from harming women and killing unborn children. All over the country, women taking abortion pills are suffering extreme bleeding and hemorrhaging resulting in hospitalization or death. They are being told that these at-home abortion pills are safe. They are not safe.

OTHER NEWS

California, Illinois, and Iowa regarding Assisted Suicide:

Assisted suicide has been legal in California since 2015 for people with a terminal illness. That is bad enough, but California has considered a suicide bill that would allow even non-terminal patients to kill themselves. This is the natural outgrowth of the pro-euthanasia/death movement nationwide. Under this proposed California law, patients who are not dying now, but who have a “serious and incurable disease” can get suicide drugs. The current law states the person must be in imminent danger of death (i.e., a prognosis of 6 months or less to live) in order to kill themselves. There is a continuing pro-death movement in California to expand this law and force doctors who disagree to provide drugs to patients who want to kill themselves. Fortunately, a lawsuit in 2022 stopped that expansion.

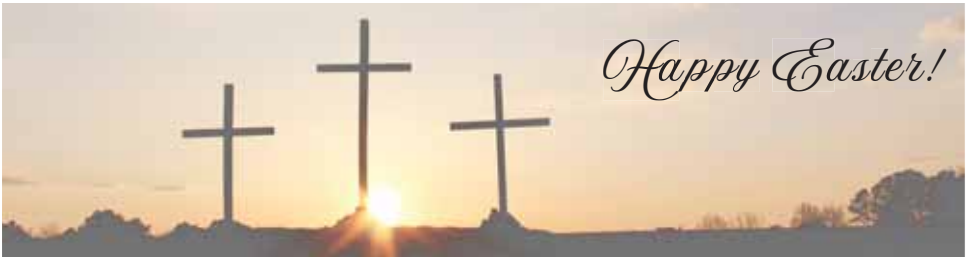

Iowa does not allow assisted suicide, although bills have been repeatedly introduced by Democrat senators and representatives to do so. These bills have been stopped in their tracks by the pro-life Republican majority in the Iowa Legislature.

According to Iowa's own Dr. Tim Millea of Bettendorf, a pro-life physician who follows developments in this area as Chair of the Catholic Medical Association Health Care Policy Committee, our neighbor Illinois is considering a so-called "MAID" law (i.e. medical aid in dying). This bill would even allow a doctor to go to the person's home to help kill them if the hospital where the doctor works would not allow it.

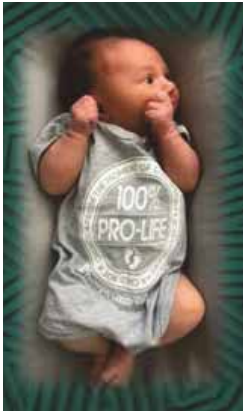
All of these so-called aid-in-dying laws are bad. It is that short and simple. Such laws endanger the elderly, disabled, and those in nursing homes, who, due to their non-terminal health condition, cannot speak or advocate for themselves. Over time, it will be assumed that they would want to kill themselves because that would be seen as a social good if a state would ever pass a MAID law. Moreover, these pro-death laws eventually lead to laws that allow anyone who feels they do not want to live because of a condition of ill health to kill themselves. The history of California's pro-death movement is proof of that.
