GENERATIONS FOR LIFE SUMMER CAMP!

DCRTL and Ambassadors for Life are excited to host our second annual Generations for Life Summer Camp from July 8th to July 12th, 2025 at the Bean Farm in Scotch Grove! We want to invite all highschoolers, ages 14-18 (rising freshman in highschool to rising freshman in college) to attend our summer camp in which students will become more equipped to protect the pre-born through learning opportunities and activism while also enjoying fellowship, prayer, games, and times for reflection and relaxation.

Students who attended last year's summer camp say they not only bonded with their peers on a deeper level, but they also learned how to defend pre-born babies and have productive dialogue with others concerning abortion. One student noted they gained skills to "properly talk to people about abortion and more about how to help take care of women and be proactive." Students who attend this year's camp can expect that and so much more with the extended camp! This camp is an excellent opportunity for high school students to be transformed and engage the community as pro-life advocates.

Because we are expanding our camp this year, we have increased the cost. However, because of generous supporters and donors like you, we are still offering the camp at a discounted price. Cost is \$125 per person if you register by Friday, May 16th. If you sign-up after this date, the price increases to \$150 per person. Final deadline to register is June 13th. PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life-

IOWA NEWS

By the time you read this column, we will know whether the so-called Baby Olivia bill was passed by the Iowa Legislature. This bill would require students in grades 4-12th be shown a “A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation, or an ultrasound or other real image, that depicts the humanity of the unborn child by showing prenatal human development, starting at fertilization, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ development throughout every stage of pregnancy.” Call our office at 563-556-5960 to inquire about the status of the bill, and watch for email alerts. The legislative session is to end on Friday, May 2, 2025.

The other bill I referenced in the April Newsletter was House File (HF) 775. It was an informed consent bill that would have aided women considering killing their child via the abortion pill. This is because the bill would have required abortionists to inform the mother in writing“of all of the risks commonly associated with a medication abortion, that it may be possible to reverse the intended effects of a medication abortion if the woman changes her mind but that time is of the essence, and that information on and assistance with reversing the effects of a medication abortion is available on the department of health and human services internet.” It also would have required such pills to be dispensed in a “health care setting,” which means a hospital, clinic, or doctor’s office. Currently, these death pills come right to the door of the distressed woman for her to ingest alone...and then deliver her dead baby in a bathroom toilet. So-called “medication abortions” are a barbaric practice and do women no favors. Unfortunately, this bill died in the legislature for lack of support. It will be eligible for revival in the 2026 legislative session, but the fact that it did not pass this year is extremely disappointing. It is a failure of the prolife movement, but only for now.

NEWS FROM OTHER STATES

Kansas - Good news from the state often referred to as the nation’s breadbasket. They passed both a Baby Olivia-video type law on April 10th (HF 2382), overriding the pro-abortion governor’s veto. The pro-life legislature also passed a bill that provides child support for pregnant women from the moment of conception. Bravo!

Wisconsin - Unfortunately, Wisconsin elected pro-abortion Supreme Court Justice Susan Crawford over pro-life candidate Brad Schimmel on April 1st, in a setback for the pro-life movement in the Badger State. However, the Wisconsin pro-life movement is vibrant and undeterred. They will keep on fighting, and hope to showcase their unceasing efforts during their March for Life on June 14, 2025 at the state capitol in Madison.

South Carolina - South Carolina has taken a federal court case all the way to the U.S. Supreme Court, where the pro-aborts want to force it to fund Planned Parenthood and provide Medicaid abortions. A case entitled *Medina v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic* was heard in an oral argument on April 2, 2025 by the 9 Supreme Court Justices in Washington, D.C.

South Carolina wants to exclude Planned Parenthood from the state’s Medicaid program because it provides abortions. Medicaid is a federal program administered by each state, bound by certain restrictions imposed by Congress. The most important one is that no Medicaid funds may be used for abortion. After South Carolina determined that Planned Parenthood was not qualified to receive taxpayer funding because PP kills babies, a federal district court forced South Carolina to restore Planned Parenthood’s funding.

The federal judge ruled that Medicaid recipients have a right to choose their preferred provider. In this case, it is a diabetes patient who wants to receive her birth control at Planned Parenthood rather than at other available clinics that do not kill babies.

The exact legal question is whether an individual patient can choose to get her Medicaid-funded care at a facility that is excluded from Medicaid funding because it kills babies, thus overriding the U.S. Congress's and South Carolina's rights under federal and South Carolina law.

A decision that will have national implications is expected by Summer 2025.

Illinois - A federal judge in Illinois issued a decision that was good and bad for the pro-life participants. On the one hand, it struck down as unconstitutional a requirement that pro-life doctors tout the supposed "benefits" of abortion when they counsel women seeking help at pregnancy resource centers. The judge ruled that forcing doctors to do this violated their First Amendment rights.

Unfortunately, the judge also ruled that if a woman asks for information about abortion, the pro-life physician must provide information about where they can obtain an abortion. The pro-life lawyers from the Thomas More Society are going to appeal the second ruling to the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals. The state of Iowa is located in the Eighth Circuit, so any ruling will not directly impact Iowa, although any of the appellate court's reasoning could be cited if a similar case arises in Iowa. Pro-life legal scholars are watching this case closely, and so will DCRTL.

That's all for now. Thanks for reading to the end! Stay informed and educated on the Life issues. Dubuque County Right to Life, Inc. will help you do just that.

Between the Dubuque County Fair and our other outreach events I was able to have hundreds of conversations about abortion with people of all ages and from all different walks of life. The Payne Family and I stayed up for nearly 24 hours straight as we arrived in Des Moines early in the morning and left very late at night, but the experience was well worth the sleep we missed out on. Witnessing the life-saving heartbeat bill become a part of the State of Iowa and being a part of an organization that aided in this legislation is definitely one of the coolest things I have ever done in my life.

Over the summers, I also spent many Thursdays going down to the Emma Goldman Abortion Clinic in Iowa City. I was able to give abortion-minded women pamphlets which contained Pro-Life Pregnancy Resource information and pray for their change of heart. With witnessing the evil of abortion many of these Thursdays, my passion to defend life continued to grow and being a witness outside clinics will be something I do in every city or state the Lord places me in next, until abortion becomes unthinkable.



News Tidbits

Victory for Life: On April 2, Planned Parenthood announced their closing of three facilities in Michigan: one in Petoskey, one in Jackson, and one in Marquette.
