A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

We polled our area for their beliefs on abortion for two reasons:

1) Obtain a more concrete idea of where our area stood on the issue of abortion. Why is this useful? Marketing professionals would share that in order to craft effective messaging, the person needs to know their audience. I agree with those who say polling isn't perfect, but I do believe it is still useful because it can highlight unforeseen gaps in our thinking about what people believe.

2) Measure the impact of our efforts over a more extended period of time. We want to make sure that our efforts throughout the year are making a difference. If they are not, we must explore other programs or initiatives that could have a greater impact.

Our goal is to change hearts and minds in our area to make abortion unthinkable. When we achieve this vision, mothers and families will be spared the regret that comes from abortion, and ultimately, generations of babies will be saved.

Method:

Over 350 responses were completed by a third-party polling firm, with the target of the poll mirroring the age demographics of Dubuque County based on Census data available. The breakdown of responses who identified with the following political ideologies was: Liberal 34%, Moderate 29%, and Conservative 36%

Good news:

Based on various polls, Dubuque County polled more pro-life than the state of Iowa polled in the recent past. According to the Des Moines Register/Mediacom Iowa Poll completed in September of 2024, the poll found that support for the heartbeat bill was 37% and 5% were unsure. In Dubuque County, support for protecting the child when the heartbeat can be detected or at conception totaled 44%, and 12% were uncertain on the timing when abortion should be allowed. Based on polling, Dubuque is more pro-life and has more uncertainty on the issue of abortion.

A significant majority of Dubuque County residents who were polled (94%) believe there should be at least some limit on what stage of pregnancy someone should be allowed to have an abortion.

Areas for growth:

1) Based on the poll, 21% of respondents said that they are personally opposed to abortion, but they believe it should be legal. During our outreach to the community, people who hold these beliefs see the immorality of abortion as a religious issue, but not a human rights violation.

2) Around 12% of respondents are unsure about the timing of when abortion should be legal. This stat is interesting because it most likely means that there are some people who are unaware of the human development process, or at least implies that they have not made up their mind on abortion.

3) Based on poll respondents, every political ideology has a notable number of people who believe that abortion should be allowed at some point in the pregnancy. Pro-life people who already have the same political ideology as people who are in favor of abortion are the best at reaching those who believe in abortion because of the shared political identity. Having things in common can help people feel more at ease and trust you enough to change their viewpoint.

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life -

I have three items for you today. One is bad, one is bad and sad, and one is hopeful.

First, the bad one. On May 26, 2023, 28-year-old Patrick Brice attacked 73-year-old Richard Schaefer and 80-year-old Mark Crosby outside a Planned Parenthood abortion clinic in Baltimore. Schaefer and Crosby were counseling women there and offering help when the criminal stopped, spoke briefly with them in an animated, hostile manner, and then viciously attacked both men. Both of the pro-lifers were badly hurt, with Crosby suffering a bloody face, bruises, severe head trauma, and permanent damage to his right eye. It took almost 2 years for the case to get to trial, after which a jury found the criminal guilty of two counts of second-degree assault and reckless endangerment. Unfortunately, he was found not guilty of first-degree assault by the judge.

It is difficult to watch this video, but doing so will show how extremely bad and unjust the judge's sentence is. With your own quick Google search, you can easily locate a picture of Crosby's horrific injuries. In a victim impact statement to the judge before sentencing, Crosby reminded the judge that the criminal had beaten him and then "left him for dead."

Due to the nature of the assault and the permanent injuries, prosecutors asked for a 10-year prison sentence. However, in a very, very bad decision, the judge sentenced the criminal to one year home detention, and three years' (added apostrophe) probation. No jail time! That means the criminal is allowed to live in his home, watch TV, exercise, and have all the comforts of home. He must attend anger management classes, drug and alcohol screening, and take part in any recommended treatment.

It was a bad act by the criminal and a bad act by the judge.

A country that tolerates the harm abortion does to women and unborn children also more easily tolerates harming pro-life people who only want to help these women. However, we must continue to offer all the help that pregnant women need to choose life, regardless of the risk.

Now the sad one. The Bloomington, Illinois police department reports that on August 23, 2025, officers responded to an emergency medical call at 7 PM. According to the press release from the City of Bloomington:

"The investigation revealed a suspect administered abortion inducing drugs to the victim without her knowledge or consent. After this occurred, the victim began experiencing medical complications and suffered a miscarriage, resulting in the loss of her pregnancy."

The suspect, a 31-year-old male, is charged with two counts of Intentional Homicide of an Unborn Child, which is a crime under 720 ILCS 5/9-1.2. (Note: This seemingly pro-life Illinois law has an exception for an abortion performed with the mother's consent.) Area TV station WCIA reports that the suspect is the mother's boyfriend, and he wanted her to abort their child. When she refused, he placed abortion pills he had purchased for \$50 in her food or drink. When police arrived, the mother was in the bathroom crying. The Catholic News Agency reports that the police found a dead baby in the toilet. The mother was reportedly seven weeks pregnant. This case illustrates the sad truth that expectant mothers and their pre-born babies are always the victims when abortion pills are used. These poison pills always harm the mother and kill the child. Women deserve better than abortion, and it is sad to think the humanity of an unborn in Illinois and other states depends on whether the pills are taken voluntarily by the mother, or involuntarily.

Now, some hopeful news. Iowa's Safe Haven Law is working, slowly but surely. Iowa HHS reports that a baby boy, born September 8, 2025 is now in the care and custody of the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and will be placed with a foster family until permanent placement is determined.

This makes a total of 78 infants saved since the law went into effect more than two decades ago, and the fourth infant in 2025.

Iowa's Safe Haven Act allows any parent who feels they cannot care for an infant to take the baby to a hospital, police, or fire station and safely leave him/her there without fault or blame. This applies to any baby up to 90 days old. The parent may also call 911 and give the infant to the first responder. The parent does not have to identify themselves and cannot be charged with neglect or abandonment for bringing their child to safety. Iowa HHS then works to place these infants in an approved foster home while awaiting permanent adoption.

This should give us hope and inspire us to never stop working for legislation and court rulings that help pregnant women and their unborn children.

Thanks for reading. Stay pro-life, and stay informed. DCRTL will help you do that.
